The American People's Historical Society of Burlington, Vermont (formerly Green Mountain Media) is happy to announce the production of a series of six sound filmstrips on Vermont history designed specifically for Vermont schoolchildren 3rd to 5th grades. The six filmstrips are; "Ethan Allen and the Green Mountain Boys," "The Battle of Bennington," "Calvin Coolidge-President from Vermont," "The Vermont Flood of 1927," "Vermont, The Civil War and the Battle of Gettysburg " and "Great Statesmen from Vermont."

Last Spring we released a series of sound filmstrips on Vermont history for students 6 th grade and up. The excellent response we received from educators throughout the state to that series has prompted us to produce another series for younger students. This new series has been completely revised for use with 3 rd to 5 th grade students. Each filmstrip contains at least 40 frames, is accompanied by a cassette and printed material.

The cost of each sound filmstrip is $\$ 18.50$ - with a $10 \%$ discount offered for the purchase of all six for $\$ 99.90$. The filmstrips are available for a free, ten day trial period and can be ordered by sending in the enclosed order form. Ethan Allen and the Green Mountain Boys

The Revolutionary War against the British had already begun in earnest at Lexington and Concord.

Crossing Lake Champlain in two small boats in the middle of the night, Allen and his men caught the British completely unprepared-and captured the Fort without firing a shot. This filmstrip Green Mt. The Battle of Bennington
The Battle of Bennington is considered by
many historians to be the many histoint of the Revolutionary War. Fought at North Hoosick, New York, a combined "citizens army" of men from New Hampshire, Massachusetts and Vermont, under the leadership of General John Stark, successfully defeated a British expeditionary force which sought to capture the American supply base at Bennington, Vermont. hand to hand, was oxtreme hand to hand, was extreme ly bitter and, at one on the verge of defeat. Two months after the sur prise American victory at Bennington, British General John Burgoyne surrendered his entire army to the Americans at Saratoga.


Vermont, the Civil War, and the Battle of Gettysburg

In proportion to population, the State Vermont lost more men for the Union cause than did any other state. This mont's mont's opposition to slav ery before the Civil War, and the role that its Battle of Gettysburg-th Battle of Gettysburg-the
major battle of the Civil War. In that battle, unde the leadership of General George Stannard, the Vermont Brigade played a key role in turning back the ferocious Confederate attack since named "Pickett's Charge."

On the night of November 2,1927, at about. ember 2,1927, at about ten o'clock in the evenVermont. It rained all through that night and continued raining during the next day. already filled to capacity. This one hour rainfall was the greatest burst of rain that anyone in Vermont had ever seen. This filmstrip describes the flood of 1927- and the damage and sufferling wrought by the flood of Gov. John E. Weeks; "the greatest natural disaster in the history of the state."
